Brush Collection

April 22nd June 24th,
August 26th October 28th

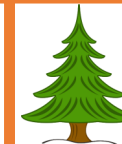
- Place brush out on your terrace by **6am** on the date of collection
- Please be patient as it may take crews several days to get through the entire City.
- Any trees/brush cut by a paid contractor will NOT be collected.
- Please **do not** set out root balls as they will not be collected.



Leaf Collection

Spring.....March 25th — April 21st
Fall.....October 7th — December 1st

- **Leaves can be put out on any day within the above timeframes**
- Please place leaves on your terrace and not in the roadway.
- Do not mix brush, trash, pumpkins, etc in with your leaves. Your leaves may not get picked up if these items are in the leaf pile.
- Please be patient as it takes crews several days to get through the City.



Christmas Tree Collection

January 2nd January 8th
January 15th

- Please be patient as it may take crews several days to get through the entire City.
- Please remove all bags, stands, lights, decorations, etc from the tree before you set it out for collection.

E-waste

- Household electronics will now be collected curbside by John's Disposal. You must call **262-473-4700** to schedule a collection time.
- You are allowed two (2) household electronic disposals per year as part of your solid waste collection fee.
- Please place electronics on your terrace for collection. Please do not put them in the roadway.
- Visit www.johnsdisposal.com or call **262-473-4700** for a full list of allowed E-waste items
- E-waste will still be collected at the Public Works Facility on Hwy A, but an additional fee may apply.

Bulky Item Collection

- You must call Johns Disposal at **262-473-4700** to schedule a bulky item collection time.
- John's no longer picks up bulky items unless you call **262-473-4700** to schedule a collection.
- You are allowed one (1) bulky item collection per month at no additional charge. You can call anytime during the month to schedule your collection.
- Please place bulky items on your terrace for collection. Please do not put them in the roadway.

Recycling

Please place the following recyclables in your Cart:

- Aluminum cans and foil
- Empty tin cans and aerosol cans
- Empty paint cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- #1-7 plastic containers
- Newspaper, magazines, books, mail, school/office paper
- Brown corrugated cardboard
- Grey chipboard (cereal and shoe boxes)
- Brown paper bags
- Shredded paper (place in clear plastic bags)



Please **Do Not** place the following items in your cart:

- Plastic Bags - Greasy Pizza Boxes - Toys - Trash - Electronics
- Food or liquids - No Styrofoam - Hose/rope - Tires - Paint

Frequently Asked Questions:

Where is the Public Works building what are hours of operation? We are located at 2439 County Hwy A Stoughton, WI. Hours of operation are Monday—Thursday 7:00am to 4:00pm and Friday 8:00am to Noon

Why can't I set out root balls? Root balls contain dirt, rocks and other material that may damage the equipment that we use to shred the brush. Small root balls can be placed in your trash and larger root balls maybe taken to the landfill for disposal.

Why can't you come back and get my brush if I put it out late? City staff have many tasks to perform. We don't have the time or personnel to keep coming back for those that choose to not put there brush out on the collection date. Furthermore, if we did it for one resident, we'd have to do it for all.

Where can I take my brush, leaves and other yard waste material in between collections? You can bring that material to the yard waste and compost facility located at 1101 Collins Rd. There is an annual permit fee of \$20 to use the site. See the Public Works website for hours of operation.
